JOB SUMMARY AND ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

Responsible for providing direction to the lifeguard staff. Provide a constant vigil over patrons in assigned areas, render first aid as necessary, and instruct Lifeguard Training classes. Assist the Aquatics and Fitness Coordinator in a variety of functions as assigned, including assisting in the coordination of event staff, maintaining equipment, and performing maintenance and custodial duties. Will oversee the daily and special event schedules, will assist in training, and perform other similar or related duties as necessary and required. Must be able to work days, nights and weekends.

Experience and Training Guidelines:

Experience or training:

Previous lifeguard experience is required, including experience in lifeguard training and instruction; experience with pool mechanical systems is also required.

Applicants must be 16 years of age or older by their first day of employment, AND be enrolled in high school (home school included) or have earned a high school diploma or GED.

License or Certificate:

- Must have current American Red Cross Lifeguard certification or YMCA Lifeguard certification.
- CPR for the Professional Rescuer, AED certification, and Community First Aid and Safety certification OR equivalent required.

Selected applicant must pass a background investigation and drug screen, and may be required to supply a current driving record.
